



2020 FUNDamental Swim Camp Rules, Guidelines and Procedures (06.24.20)

- These are in addition to our regular Camp Rules, Guidelines and Procedures.
- COVID-19 Release form must be completed, signed, and returned prior to starting in addition to Online release forms.
- All campers should use their own bathroom prior to coming to swim.
- All swimmers (and Coaches) must bring and have completed and signed the "Swimmer/Camper/Coach Health Monitoring Form" on a daily basis! We will scan each campers' forehead temperature and record it on the form upon entering the pool area prior to camp EVERY day. If any questions are answered with "yes" or the temperature scan is above 100.3, swim campers or coaches will not be allowed to swim or coach! No Refunds will be given!
- Swim Campers are to enter and exit the pool area while maintaining a minimum distance of 6 feet apart.
- Parents stay in their cars, and do not enter the pool gate. Swim Campers only. Parents may accompany the younger swim campers to the front gate.
- Swimmers and Coaches will maintain a 6-foot distance and wear face masks or shields when not in the pool. Coaches in the pool will wear face shields. Coaches in the pool may have physical contact with campers for the sole purpose of teaching and correcting swimming strokes/technique.
- Swim Campers should arrive 10 minutes early.
- After leaving their respective cars with face masks on, swim campers walk to designated waiting area by the pool front gate where they will maintain a 6-foot distance apart.
- When instructed, walk in separately, 6 feet apart, submit their Health Monitoring Forms & have their temperature scanned.
- Swim Campers arrive at the pool with suits on under clothes. No locker-rooms, showering or deck changing. Swimmers are to wear their suit to the pool.
- Swim Campers must bring a personal (folding) chair and their own "kick board" and "equipment bag" with them and leave with them – no storing of personal chairs or training equipment at the pool. NO shared equipment or chairs. Kick boards & Equipment Bags may be purchased during the registration process or at the pool (from South Florida Aquatic Supply).
- Swim Campers enter the Westminster pool deck at the front (south) main pool entrance gate, proceed to their camp group area (tent) and put their belongings in their personal folding chair.
- Each swimmer is to bring their own hand sanitizer and apply upon entering and exiting the pool area.
- Swim Campers will remove face masks prior to entering the pool to swim.
- Swim Campers must remain with their camp group in their area (in and out of the water) at all times.
- Locker rooms will remain locked. If swimmers require the use a bathroom for an emergency (only), they may use the bathrooms by the gym. Camp staff will escort one swimmer at a time to use the bathroom at any given time. The bathroom will be cleaned following use.
- Upon exiting the pool, swim campers will put their face masks on.
- Swim Campers will depart immediately at the conclusion of their camp day and before the next camp group arrives and enters the pool area. Swimmers may have to exit and walk around tennis courts to parents' cars.
- No one is permitted to loiter in the parking lot or anywhere on the Westminster Christian School Campus.
- Parents must be ready to pick their swim camper up immediately at the conclusion of camp.
- Swim Campers must exit 6 feet apart.
- Swim Campers that do not follow these rules will be removed from camp and NO Refund will be given.
- Pool Deck will be sanitized daily.



Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

AquaKids has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, AquaKids cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending practice and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 maybe as a result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, AquaKids' and Westminster Christian School's employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, death, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind), that I, or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at AquaKids at Westminster Christian School's facilities or participation in any such organized training, teaching or camp sessions ("Claims"). On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless to AquaKids, Westminster Christian School, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of AquaKids and Westminster Christian School, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any of the organized activities.
