

Reservation Transfer, Cancellation & Refund Policy & General Information

Your reservation covers the nights and campsites listed on your confirmation and includes a camping permit for one (1) vehicle for each campsite, which will be distributed to the first vehicle arriving for check-in. Additional vehicles, cabled and tagged vessels and/or pets are not included in your reservation. These are extra charges that are paid for upon arrival. Camping permits are non-transferable and valid only for the vehicle/unit for which the permit is originally issued.

A maximum of eight (8) persons and three (3) vehicles per site are allowed when applicable User Fees are paid.

Group and Overflow Areas: Camping permits in these areas are issued as primary vehicles only, please refer to the Public Use Fees for specific pricing.

1. Weekends and Holiday Weekends

(a) A 2-night minimum (Friday and Saturday) is required for weekend which cannot be split up.

(b) A 3-night minimum may be required for some holiday weekends which cannot be split up.

2. Transfers

Transfers can be made up to and including the day before scheduled arrival date until close of regular business hours. Transfers must be made to a future date not more than 180 days from date of transfer. A \$5 per site fee will be charged at the time of transfer.

3. Reservation Cancellation Refund Policy

(a) Notice received more than 72-hours (3 days) prior to arrival date, refund of camp fees minus reservation fee(s) (\$9 per site) and cancellation fee(s) (\$5 per site).

(b) Notice received less than 72-hours prior to arrival date, NO REFUND until 72-hour notice requirement has been met per 3(a) above.

(c) NO REFUNDS will be made for required nights of 2 or 3 night minimum (weekends/holidays). See paragraph 1 above.

(d) NO REFUNDS will be made for inclement weather outside of regular cancellations.

(e) Where applicable, refunds are processed upon receipt of a completed LCRA Request for Refund Form. No cash refunds will be made.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Because Lake Casitas is a domestic drinking water reservoir, body contact of any kind with lake water and waterways flowing into Lake Casitas is prohibited. Body contact includes, but is not limited to, wading or swimming by any person, child, or pet.

Upon entering the Park, please be prepared to verify the name of the person who made the reservation and the site number. If you have multiple reservations, permits will be distributed in the order of arrival as described in the reservation notes.

Minors camping in the park must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Check-In Time: 2:00 pm; Check-Out Time: 12:00 noon.

Latest Entry: Weekdays 9:00 pm; Weekends 10:00 pm.

Quiet Hours: 10:00pm to 8:00am. Noise from radios, generators and group activities sound much louder after sundown. Please be courteous to your fellow campers.

ATTENTION BOATERS!! - Due to the potential threat of invasive species, Lake Casitas has **RESTRICTED ACCESS TO ALL VESSELS** entering the park. All vessels must be inspected and complete a 35-day quarantine before being allowed access to the lake. Boat rentals are also available. For the most current information, please call (805) 649-2233, select option #2.

Tents and plastic pools are not allowed in any landscaped, irrigated areas. In non-irrigated areas, prior approval from a member of the Park Staff must be obtained before setting up pools or other similar items.

Within the park, the speed limit is 15 MPH on the main road and 5 MPH in all campgrounds, picnic areas and parking lots. Additionally, all applicable sections of the California Vehicle Code apply, including mandatory safety belt use and prohibition of passenger transport in truck beds.

At all times pets must be kept on a leash of 6 feet or less, under the supervision and control of a responsible party and remain inside a tent, camping unit or enclosed vehicle during quiet hours. Pets are not allowed within 50 feet of the lake shoreline or streams. Dogs are allowed on vessels.
