It's becoming clear that Boca Raton is now a major destination for quality restaurant groups considering expansion. We've already seen the likes of Zed451 and Uncle Julio's add Boca to their burgeoning empires. Next up: Copper Canyon Grill.

You've probably seen the construction of Copper Canyon going on along Glades Road, near I-95. Trust me, the opening in early September (Sept. 7 is the scheduled date) will be worth the wait. This is the same restaurant group responsible for Red Rock Canyon Grill, the nearest of which is in Orlando. The kids and I dined at Red Rock during a trip last year to Universal -- and my children are still talking about the wood-fired rotisserie chicken, which they swear is the best they've ever had. This may be the greatest endorsement any restaurant could receive, because chicken is practically the only thing my kids eat.

There will be, however, plenty more on the menu, described by the owners as full-flavored American cuisine—including some killer hickory grilled steaks and pork chops, barbecue ribs, and much more.
