Research Fellowship



The Everglades Foundation is announcing fellowships for advanced research in support of the restoration of the Florida Everglades. The goal of the Everglades Foundation Fellowship program is to support graduate students actively pursuing innovative methods in natural resources management, advances in the understanding of Everglades' physical, chemical or biological processes, or research in economic, legal, political, or cultural factors directly related to Everglades restoration.

ELIGIBILITY

The fellowship is open to full-time graduate students pursuing degrees in the natural sciences, biological sciences, engineering, geography, planning and resources management, law, economics and the social sciences. We are especially interested in students pursuing cross-disciplinary research.

AWARDS

The fellowship is a one-time award of up to \$15,000 to cover tuition/fees, stipends, and research-related expenses. Up to 4 fellowships are available. Recipients will also be invited to the annual Everglades Gala to accept their award.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS
