Fund your upgrade projects

Once you've decided on your improvements, you can apply online or in person for Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) financing through the Energy Independence Program. The minimum amount of financing is \$2,500. The financed amount becomes an assessment attached to the property, not the owner, and is paid back through the property tax system over a 10 or 20 year term with a 7 percent simple interest rate. In addition to PACE, there are several other options for financing. Our staff can help you find what's best for you.


