## **Judging**

- Banners should appeal to a broad horse-loving audience.
- We recommend that banners are done on artist canvas (pre-primed roll) or standard vinyl banner fabric and are supported by a wooden rod at the top.
- Banners should be no smaller than 2' x 4' and no larger than 3' x 8'.
- Banners should NOT use photographs, images, graphics that infringe on someone else's copyright or trademark.
- Banners will be judged during Barn Night on Thursday, October 25, while hung in a designated area on the Verizon Center concourse. Decision of judges is final.

- 4. Video must be a maximum length of two (2) minutes, including titles.
- 5. Video must be delivered as a QuickTime file (via non returnable thumb drive/Data DVD), DVC ProHD tape, DVCam tape or MiniDV tape. The QT file should be submitted at the highest resolution possible. High definition video is preferred, but not required.
- 6. Video entry must be your original work and not previously published.
- 7. Video Submissions must not contain any elements of music, audio, speech/voiceover or other audiovisual material that is protected by someone else's copyright or trade secret or otherwise subject to third party rights. Video Submissions must include music credit. (Suggested websites: audiojungle.com, soundcloud.com, newground.com)
- 8. Employees and Independent Contractors of WIHS are not eligible to enter.
- 9. No video submissions will be returned.
- 10. Privacy Finalists and winners may be publicly identified by name and town.
- 11. Video submissions must adhere to the norms of civil discourse and must be suitable for viewing by individuals of any age and not contain profanity.
