2019 KLINGER PERPETUAL AWARD FOR HONOR & SERVICE Presented by EQUUS Foundation

The Klinger Perpetual Award for Honor and Service was created in 2013 to honor Klinger, a special horse who has touched the lives of many in his life of service with the 3<sup>rd</sup> U.S. Infantry Regiment (The Old Guard) Caisson Platoon. Among his duties, Klinger has served as the official escort to the President of the United States, led the Presidential Inaugural Parade, and acted as a TAPS Ambassador bringing comfort to veterans and families of our fallen heroes. Klinger has been inducted to the Horse Stars Hall of Fame by EQUUS Foundation and USEF for his service.

Klinger has also been an important part of the Washington International Horse Show for a number of years, visiting with children on WIHS Kids' Day, joining the Breakfast with the Mounted Police, and participating in the Caisson Platoon exhibition on WIHS Military Night.

The Klinger Perpetual Award for Honor and Service presented by EQUUS Foundation, will recognize a horse, individual or organization each year that best demonstrates the values of honor and service as embodied by Klinger.
