2017 KLINGER PERPETUAL AWARD FOR HONOR & SERVICE Presented by EQUUS Foundation, the Stephens Family, and the American Horse Council

The Klinger Perpetual Award for Honor and Service was created in 2013 to honor Klinger, a special horse who has touched the lives of many in his life of service with the 3rd U.S. Infantry Regiment (The Old Guard) Caisson Platoon. Among his duties, Klinger has served as the official escort to the President of the United States, led the Presidential Inaugural Parade, and acted as a TAPS Ambassador bringing comfort to veterans and families of our fallen heroes. Klinger has been inducted to the Horse Stars Hall of Fame by EQUUS Foundation and USEF for his service.

Klinger has also been an important part of the Washington International Horse Show for a number of years, visiting with children on WIHS Kids' Day, joining the Breakfast with the Mounted Police, and participating in the Caisson Platoon exhibition on WIHS Military Night.

The Klinger Perpetual Award for Honor and Service presented by EQUUS Foundation, The Stephens Family, and American Horse Council will recognize a horse, individual or organization each year that best demonstrates the values of honor and service as embodied by Klinger.

Nominations must be received by Friday, September 15, 2017

The award recipient will be notified in early October and will be invited to participate in an award presentation on WIHS Military Night on Friday, October 27, 2017 at Verizon Center in Washington, DC. The award recipient will receive saddle pads from the American Horse Council and may select an equine charity on the Equine Welfare Network of the EQUUS Foundation to receive a \$500 grant from the EQUUS Foundation matched by a \$500 donation from the Stephens Family.
